Summary

The CCTV (Closed Circuit Television) Operator will be responsible for operating and maintaining surveillance equipment, watching both live and recorded video surveillance footage.

Essential Duties

The CCTV (Closed Circuit Television) Operator duties include but are not limited to the following. These duties describe the minimum activities of this position. These duties are subject to change to accommodate the needs of the company.

Responsibilities

- Operating and Maintaining Surveillance equipment
- Watching both live and recorded video surveillance footage
- Reporting incidents or suspicious behavior and contacting authorities when necessary.
- Operator must always be mindful of maintaining a safe work environment, adhering to the health and safety protocol always without exception.
- Operator will perform standard CCTV inspection jobs on various types of pipelines, including setting up and breaking down equipment, capturing videos, managing data, troubleshooting and maintenance.
- Technical and manual skills are required for completing inspection jobs, including the use of various industry software programs and some manual labor.
- Duties may include assisting with cleaning/jetting lines when necessary.

Qualification Requirements

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill and/ or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. Related industry experience in one of the following areas is strongly preferred: Hydrovac Excavation, Pipeline Inspection, Pipeline Rehabilitation, Pipeline Cleaning, Oil and Gas, and Commercial Underground Construction.

Education and/or Experience

- Individual must demonstrate proficiency with safety protocol both on and off the jobsite, as a safe work environment is of maximum importance.
- NASSCO Pipeline Assessment Certification Program (PACP), Lateral Assessment Certification Program (LACP), and Manhole Assessment Certification Program (MACP) certifications are preferred.
- Must be able to locate manholes from a map
- Prior experience with utility cleaning and inspection, and general knowledge of water distribution and sewage collection systems is preferred.
- Individual must be accountable, professional, team oriented, and organized with the ability to work on multiple jobs/tasks at once.
- Knowledge or experience with CUES GraniteNet, Granite XP, POSM, or IBAK/Panorama equipment is a plus

Communication Skills

Ability to communicate effectively, verbally, and written skills with customers and employees. Excellent interpersonal skills.

Computer Skills

Proficient in Microsoft Office, word, excel and outlook, and sales software. Proficient with CCVT equipment.

Organizational Skills

Must have organizational skills and be detail oriented. Ability to manage multiple responsibilities and accounts.

Physical Demands

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to use hands to handle or feel objects, tools, or controls; reach with hands and arms; and talk or hear. The employee frequently is required to sit, stand, and walk. The employee is occasionally required to climb, or balance, and stoop, kneel crouch, or crawl.

The employee occasionally is required to lift and/or move up to 25 pounds and to walk up to ½ mile daily. Specific vision abilities by this job include close vision and distance vision.

Work Environment

The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee occasionally works near moving mechanical parts; in outside weather conditions and is occasionally exposed to wet and/or humid conditions, and fumes or airborne particles.

The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate.
